

Everyone does this using sign language only. Keep in mind not all details are from proper sign language, but still convey the message.

Hold hands up to the sky with all fingers up

Put down thumb and little finger and move hands in little arcs

Put other fingers down leaving index finger up still moving in an arc

Fold arms across body, putting open hands on chest

Extend thumbs, sliding the tips up and down

Touch lower lip with right hand index finger, then rub right hand tips on left hand

Put your hands over your face in shame

Tap right hand little finger on left side of chest

Right hand thumb on right forehead

Extend little finger both hands cross hands across chest

Brushing off right hand over left hand

Index fingers move sharply towards each other twice

Tap left fist with index/middle/ring fingers of right hand twice

Point to your heart

Point to your mind

Sweep left hand with right hand fingers

Move right hand index finger in air

Crook left hand index finger out at front, moving it towards right shoulder

Point to yourself

Fold arms, rocking and holding like a baby

Hammer nails into your hands

Put a spear into your side

Index and middle fingers of both hands – vertical drops, turning palms forward

Cross and uncross open hands in front of body

Hold left fist in front of body, moving open right hand down to hit back of left fist

Clean out ears

Point to a clock

Point to yourself

Point to your ears

Point to your eyes

Kneel, putting hands in prayer formation

Each person then gets up and gives a single line prayer with their hands

Move fingertips from open right hand from chin

Point upwards with right hand index finger

Place tip of right hand middle finger into an open left hand then reverse

Open right hand palm facing downwards move in arc

Extend thumbs of both hands, move towards each other rising higher each time

Right index and middle fingers moving in an arc to right shoulder

Form fists with both hands, moving across arms at the wrists

Point upwards with hands
